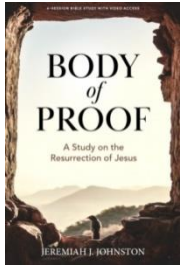


**Starting Strong Apartment Kits: We will be assembling TODAY after worship. Please join us for this special time of fellowship and commissioning.**
