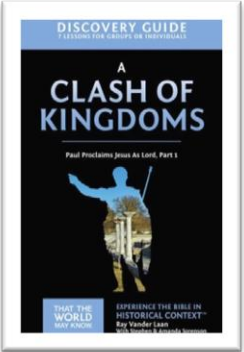


Inclement Weather Policy:
