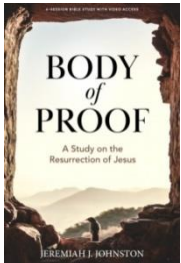
Campaign: Reaching Her from Mother’s Day through Father’s Day.
