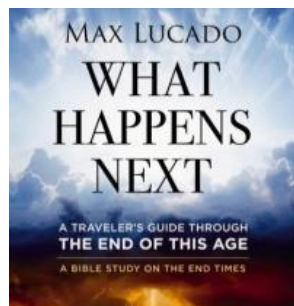


Today is **SCRIP Sunday!** Please see Gaye Gibson to order your gifts cards today.
